Also in attendance were Marion Chupasco and Judy Rudolph. Pastor Jay opened the meeting with a prayer. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved with a correction. Treasurers' reports were given and filed for audit.

**Pastor's report:** 2 pre baptisms, 2 private counseling sessions, Library board meetings, 1 funeral. Pastor Jay apologized for the scheduling and canceling of the August 2 worship service, with the weather causing confusion. Both Brandonville and Ringtown services were recorded for YouTube. Pastor Jay will check on prices of microphones and cameras that could possibly be used with the computer to do live services. The worship services under the Maple tree have helped during the hot weather. Baptisms are now being done with several to occur in August. Communion is scheduled for August 16 with precautions in place and using 2 communion assistants. Synod held a zoom meeting pertaining to Synod Assembly which will be held online on October 16, 18, 23, & 24. The main business will be electing a new bishop. 2 delegates, 1 male and 1 female are needed. There will be a registration fee to help defray the technological costs. As of now, the 2021 Synod Assembly will be held at Kalahari Resort.

**Capital Campaign:** Met by phone conference. Reviewed the proposed brochure and pledge cards.

**Building Committee:** Bob Llewellyn reported to Pastor Jay that the perk test passed and that Dave Rentschler of JMR is working on the storm water runoff testing.

New Business: The Library Food and Wine Gala has been canceled and in its place will be a basket extravaganza. The date will remain the same, 9/12/2020, and the time will be from 11a.m. until 4 p.m. The Library asked permission to use the church parking lot and to borrow tents and tables to be set up and taken down by their committees. Permission was granted. The Boy Scout Spaghetti dinner was canceled. C J Oslar's Eagle Scout Project was approved. Discussion was held on the possibility of a takeout only dinner to be held. Marion thanked council on behalf of her and Sandy for allowing them to sell masks and towels with proceeds going to the church. Council in turn thanked Marion and Sandy for doing the preparations and sale. Marion said she applied for a grant from Schuylkill County to help defray costs of cleaning supplies and things needed due to Covid 19. She hasn't heard back from anyone yet.
