**Think Tank:** Beginning in early August all vendors can apply for spaces to sell any open goods. Christmas in July was successful with approximately 150 people attending.

**Town Social:** Meeting set for August 4 at 6:30. There have been some signups for help.

**Building:** All easements and right of ways have been ok'd by the senior citizens center. All paperwork from the engineering is in the hands of borough council for signatures and approvals.

**Old Business:** The estate of Kathryn Fetterman has been settled. Once the check is received it will be deposited in the Money Market account until a decision is made on where it should go, possibly a CD. Communion at the Old White Church will be received at the end of the service as congregants leave the building. If the weather cooperates, we will hold the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sundays of September inside for communion and the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> outdoors.

**New Business:** We will prepay 4000 gallons of oil. Vacation was approved for Pastor Jay from September 2 through September 8. The new insurance contract was received to go into effect on September 1. It was suggested a cleanup around the church could be held for God's Work Our Hands which is September 12. Our next council meeting will be held on Sunday, September 12 at 6:30 due to Labor Day being on the first Monday. Wayne will have devotions.

### RINGTOWN CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

The Capital Campaign Committee has been meeting with our consultant, Mr. Gene Musser, to put the final touches on our Capital Campaign at St. John's, Ringtown, as we move toward the construction of a new church facility. We will run the campaign through the months of September, October, and November this Fall as we ask our members to consider prayerfully how each may be a part of our effort to finance the construction project. Over the coming weeks we will lay out our capital campaign process and share with you more detailed information about our building project. Soon, a congregational mailing will be sent to kick off the campaign, followed by the campaign itself. Please look to future newsletters, bulletins, and special announcements as you seek information about the process and how you can be an integral part of it. Please know that we are grateful for the many ways you participate in our ministry here at St. John's and for the many ways you contribute to help support the mission we share.

### Donating through a QCD

If you are age 70 ½ or older, IRS rules may allow you to take required minimum distributions (RMDs) each year from your tax-deferred retirement accounts (IRAs, 401(k)s, 403(b)s, 457(b)s, inherited IRA plans, etc.). If you take the RMD as income, it will count as taxable income. This additional taxable income may push you into a high tax bracket and may also reduce your eligibility for certain tax credits and deductions. To eliminate or reduce the impact of RMD income, instead consider making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) to St. John's Lutheran. Please speak with your financial advisor before taking any funds from your tax Deferred retirement account.

**NOTE:** All eligible area residents may file papers to choose to go to either the Ringtown or Nuremberg Food Pantry. You must choose one or the other, you cannot go to both.

A Food Pantry is available at the Ringtown Union Twp. building and at the North Union Twp. building in Nuremberg for all area residents of Ringtown Borough, North Union, East Union, and Union Twp. Donations of non-perishable food items are requested to help stock them. Please bring your donations to the church or other designated collection sites. Ringtown area clergy will refer people to the pantry.
