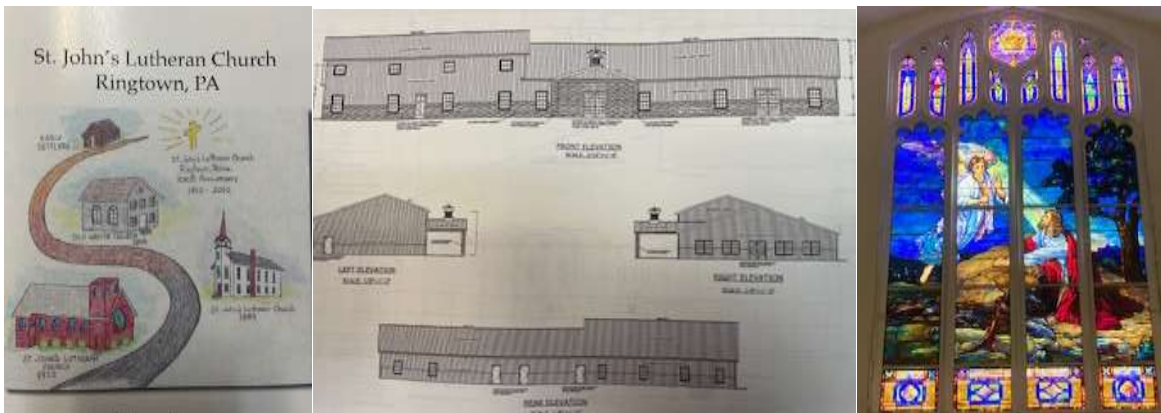


St. John's Lutheran Church, 106 W. Main St., Ringtown, PA is writing a new chapter in our ministry with and for the people of the Ringtown Valley.
